Dear OHSRA Contestants,

I hope the following information clears up some of the confusion on the Oregon High School Rodeo Scholarships. Please read through carefully and if you still have questions, please contact me.

- **The Raffle Scholarship**
 - The money earned from the raffle will fund the Raffle Scholarship. The more tickets sold, means more money will be available to fund this scholarship. The amount you can receive depends on the funds available.
 - It is a one-time scholarship and is not renewable.
 - Graduating seniors are awarded scholarships based on your active participation throughout all of your years of membership in OHSRA.
 - This scholarship is awarded to you after you complete a successful term at college. "Successful" to mean a 2.0 grade point average.
 - I don't send out letters stating how much you will be receiving from the raffle scholarship. If you sold tickets during your OHSRA participation, you will receive money.
 - At the end of your first term of college, request an official, sealed transcript from your university to be mailed to me.
 - Once I verify the GPA, the scholarship money will be paid to your university.
- **The Athletic Scholarship**
 - The auction at the State Finals will fund the Athletic Scholarship.
 - Each family is asked to donate an item for the auction. The more involvement we have, the more funds are available for the graduating class.
 - It is a one-time scholarship and is not renewable.
 - Depending on the funds available, the top placing seniors in each event at State Finals qualify. Again, depending on the funds available, this will determine how many places we go down.
 - You will be given certificates for the awards you receive at State Finals.
 - After State Finals, I will send you a letter stating which scholarships you received and the process in which to receive your money.
 - This scholarship is awarded to you after you complete a successful term at college. "Successful" to mean a 2.0 grade point average.
 - At the end of your first term of college, request an official, sealed transcript from your university to be mailed to me.
 - Once I verify the GPA, the scholarship money will be paid to you and your university.
