GRADES ---- PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR FINAL GRADES ARE EMAILED TO THE OHSRA OFFICE OR UPLOADED TO YOUR NHSRA PORTAL.

SENIORS: Be ready to help at the scholarship auction and don't forget your item. ALL seniors need to help at the auction even if you did not apply for the academic scholarship. Also, bring your gown to state, you will be recognized during the 1st performance on Thursday night beginning at 5:45 pm.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

For 2020 State Finals Rodeo the top twenty contestants in each event will need to enter. In the case that someone does not enter contestants will have the option of rolling up and will be notified if they in fact roll up. Entries for State Finals will be taken by the online process. All contestants must check in on **Wednesday, June 17th, at 3-5:00 pm**. If you cannot check in by this time, then someone may check in for you, but everyone **MUST BE CHECKED IN!** Please make sure the person checking you in has your information and money for your entry.

Team roping points—Points earned in team roping during the preliminary season will belong to contestant (regardless of heading or heeling or change of partners). At state finals, a team may be **ANY** two-team ropers with points. Each partner's points are added together to form a team. You must have a partner to enter with, you may not draw a partner for state finals, and you must declare the header and heeler at the time of entry. The top 20 TEAMS, after their points are added together, will be entered.

Contestant positions in each event are drawn for in the first go and then the order is reversed for the second go. The final go is for the top 10 contestants in the year end standings after the two long goes at state are added in. This is determined by adding 1st go points and 2nd go points to your points going into the finals rodeo. The final go positions will run from 10th place to 1st place in all events except the barrels and poles, where positions are drawn for.

This year due to short notice of all and short on \$ due to very little rodeos, OHSRA will only be offering the State Finals Qualifiers a sweatshirt. Size option will be on the online entry form. Online entries will open on Wednesday, June 10th and close Monday June 15th. If you are already qualified and clearly going to be in the top 20 please enter online as soon as possible. If you are on the bubble of being in the top 20 we will try to have points tallied ASAP after the first weekend so you can enter. The Nationals Team will get long sleeve shirts and new qualifiers will get their 1 time coat at Nationals.

GRADES:

BE SURE TO HAVE YOUR GRADES EITHER ALREADY TURNED INTO THE OHSRA OFFICE OR UPLOADED TO YOUR STUDENT PORTAL, AT THIS POINT THESE SHOULD BE YOUR FINAL GRADES.

FEES:

Fees are to be paid when you check in at state finals.

- \$35 office charge
- \$50 per event--\$30 Stock Charge & \$10 for 1st & 2nd go-around, no payoff in final round.
- \$30 for dry camping—NO electricity, camping spots in the in-field of arena

DRESS CODE:

The dress code will be in effect from the **Thursday morning – start of the rodeo- until AFTER the awards recognition Saturday**. As stated in the NHSRA rulebook—Contestants, parents, adults, helpers and assistants must wear western attire: western hat, long sleeved shirt, western boots, and western trousers at all times during a performance while in the following areas: arena, chute area, stock working area. Contestants must wear western attire in any seating area, whether competing or not. Contestants must wear numbers on their backs and the number must be visible at all times while competing in their event, when at the rodeo or rodeo grounds or any rodeo function and at the motel.

CLUB JOBS: If you are a member of a club, your club will be doing a job at state finals. You and or your parents are required to help your club in completing their job. Check with your club advisor to see what your job will be.

National Finals

You need to be prepared to go to Nationals before state finals. Attached are the entry forms for nationals. Most of the information can be completed before the end of our state finals. For example, **both parents in front of a notary could sign the releases before** you come to Prineville, and is VERY IMPORTANT if both parents are not going to attend state finals. The national form requires the signature of both parents in three places—so if they are not going to be at state it must be brought with you signed and notarized. Current Coggins Test and a brand inspection are required on all horses before traveling to Nationals or Silver State.

If you qualify for Nationals and you decide not to go, Bobbi MUST be notified ASAP.

I must have the entry forms completed after the final performance, Saturday, June 20th. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Nationals Coats ----

You must personally fill out a National Coat order form in order to receive a coat. If you qualify in one of the top 4 spots of your event, OHSRA will buy you a coat whether you attend Nationals or not, if you roll up in an event and would like to buy a coat the cost is \$275 and will never be refunded even if you qualify another year.

National High School Finals Rodeo—July 14—23, Guthrie, Oklahoma

Top 4 contestants in each event. **All contestant housing and stalls and entries go through Bobbi Aldrich, OHSRA Secretary. Money will be collected on June 20th. Camping \$350.00—full service only 14 spots, , \$200 water only 3 spots available, \$125 Dry Camping 3 spots available, \$275 full service off site 6 spots available; Stalls \$159 or stud stall \$170. Only allowed one stall per event, extra stalls are \$245. Jackpot \$150 each event and is optional. Please know the length and model of your RV. VERY Limited RV spots available this year, contestants taking horses will have first dibs on the RV spots no extra will be given.**

Nationals Hotel Info---- Any contestant wanting lodging for the NHSFR will need to make their own reservations this year. Hotels available with room blocks. These hotels will keep rooms blocked until June 30th, but I recommend you make your reservation much earlier. The list of hotels is available on the NHSRA website.

MEMBER'S RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the above-named member ("Member") being allowed to enter the restricted area (as defined below) and to participate and compete in the 2020 National High School Finals Rodeo, we, the Member, and the undersigned parent(s) or legal guardian of the Member, on behalf of the Member, and for ourselves, our personal representatives, heirs, spouse, parents, siblings, and children, do hereby:

1. RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE the National High School Rodeo Association, Inc., any other rodeo association, any rodeo committee, any stock contractor, any rodeo or event sponsors and the Lazy E Arena, and each of them and their officers, directors, trustees, managers, agents and employees (all of whom are collectively referred to herein as "Releasees") from any and all liability to the Member, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, parents, legal guardian, siblings, and their spouse and children for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the Member, his/her death or damage to his/her property (or injury, death or damage to property of any of the undersigned), which occurs as a result of the Member's or any of the undersigned's (1) presence in the restricted area, (2) participation as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in any rodeo event, and/or (3) competition for money, prizes, recognition or reward, whether such death, injury or property damage is caused by the negligence or other wrongful conduct of, breach of contract or warranty by, strict liability or otherwise by, one or more of the Releasees or other contestants.
2. AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASEES and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost (including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees and other defense costs) one or more of them may incur arising out of or related to the Member's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in any rodeo events, whether such claim is based on one or more of the Releasees' negligence, breach of contract or warranty, strict liability or other legal theory.
3. UNDERSTAND that Member's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in rodeo events contains DANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH TO MEMBER, that conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which the Member and each of the undersigned appreciate and voluntarily assume because we choose to do so. Each of the Member and undersigned has observed events of the type that the Member seeks to participate in. We further understand that the arena surface, access ways or lack thereof, lighting or lack thereof, and weather conditions all change and pose a danger to the Member and that other contestants and participants pose a danger to the Member. WE EACH VOLUNTARILY ELECT TO ASSUME AND ACCEPT ALL RISKS inherent in rodeo.
4. This Release, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement shall apply to the 2020 National High School Finals Rodeo and to any incident, injury, accident or death involving rodeo occurring on or after the date of the Member's signing. The term "restricted area" means the area from which admission to the general public is restricted, which includes, the rodeo area, competition area, chutes, pens, adjacent walkways and other appurtenances. The undersigned agree that in the event any portion of this document is held to be invalid, the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect to the greatest extent possible under applicable law. If a Member becomes of legal age after signing this document, he/she shall be deemed to have ratified this document by participating in the rodeo. If the Member is a minor, the parents or guardian of the Member agree that by signing below they are in addition to binding themselves, binding the Member to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law.

WE HAVE READ THIS RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT WE HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE, AND INTEND THIS TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY APPLICABLE LAW.
