

OHSRA RODEO 101:

PLEASE SEE THE RODEO GUIDE FOR ALL THE INFORMATION YOU WILL NEED FOR EACH RODEO. THE RODEO GUIDE MAY CHANGE AS INFORMATION IS UPDATED, THERE IS A DATE AT THE TOP OF THE RODEO GUIDE THAT REFLECTS THE LAST DATE CHANGED. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE USING THE MOST UP TO DATE RODEO GUIDE. UPDATED GUIDE IS ALWAYS AVAILABLE ON OUR WEBSITE. ENTRY LINK WILL ALSO BE ON OUR WEBSITE, BUT ONLY THE DAYS THAT ENTRIES ARE OPEN WWW.OHSRA.ORG

ENTRY FEE'S:

\$40 FOR ALL EVENTS EXCEPT \$45 ROUGH STOCK, CUTTING & RCH, \$20 PER RODEO FOR OFFICE FEE, \$40 FOR THE WEEKEND. \$10 GATE FEE PER CONTESTANT FOR WEEKEND

EACH RODEO WILL HAVE A RODEO OFFICE WHERE YOU WILL PAY YOUR ENTRY FEE FOR THAT WEEKEND'S RODEO. THIS IS ALSO THE PLACE TO CHECK YOUR DRAW AND SEE RESULTS. RODEO OFFICES USUALLY OPEN 2 HOURS BEFORE EACH PERFORMANCE.

THE FEE'S ARE PER RODEO, EVERY WEEKEND OF RODEO HAS TWO RODEOS AVAILABLE FOR THE WEEKEND. YOU DO NOT HAVE TO ENTER BOTH RODEOS, ALTHOUGH ENTERING BOTH WILL GIVE YOU TWO CHANCES EACH WEEKEND. WHEN ENTERING ONLINE THERE IS OPTIONS TO PICK RODEO #1 WHICH IS THE FIRST RODEO DURING THE WEEKEND AND RODEO #2 IS THE SECOND RODEO AVAILABLE THAT SAME WEEKEND. OR BOTH RODEOS WHICH THE MAJORITY OF COMPETITORS PICK.

ENTRING A RODEO:

THE ENTRY LINK WILL BE ON OUR WEBSITE DURING ENTRY TIME. ENTRIES ARE OPEN FOR 4 DAYS, THEY ALWAYS OPEN ON FRIDAY AND CLOSE ON MONDAY NIGHT. THE DATES IN WHICH THEY OPEN AND CLOSE ARE REFLECTED ON THE RODEO GUIDE. ONCE YOU SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY, YOU SHOULD GET AN EMAIL CONFIRMATION TO THE EMAIL YOU USED ON YOUR ENTRY. IF YOU HAVE BAD SERVICE THE ENTRY MAY OR MAY NOT SUBMIT. IF YOU DO NOT GET AN EMAIL THE ENTRY MOST LIKELY DID NOT GO THROUGH, PLEASE SUBMIT ANOTHER ENTRY IF THIS IS THE CASE.

THERE IS A BOX AT THE END OF THE ENTRY TO TELL US ANY OTHER INFORMATION. THIS IS WHERE YOU MAY NOTE THAT YOU ARE RIDING THE SAME HORSE AS ANOTHER STUDENT (NOT ALLOWED IN BARRELS OR POLES) OR TELL US YOU WILL ONLY BE AT ONE RODEO OR ANY OTHER INFORMATION WE MAY NEED TO KNOW. PLEASE USE THIS BOX AS IT IS VERY HELPFUL IN UNDERSTANDING YOUR NEEDS.

TUESDAY AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE A PRE-DRAW WILL BE POSTED ON THE WEBSITE WITH YOUR NAME AND THE EVENTS YOU ARE ENTERED IN, THIS PRE-DRAW IS YOUR ENTRY CONFIRMATION. THIS IS THE GRACE PERIOD IN WHICH EVENTS CAN BE CORRECTED OR CHANGED. YOU WILL HAVE UNTIL THURSDAY AT 10 AM TO MAKE ANY MODIFICATIONS TO YOUR ENTRIES AFTER THIS THE GRACE PERIOD ENDS AND THE OFFICIAL DRAW WILL BE DONE. DAYSHEETS FOR EACH RODEO WILL BE POSTED ON THE WEBSITE TUESDAY BEFORE THE RODEO WEEKEND.

SPECIAL SET UPS AND POINTS:

THE OHSRA BOARD OF DIRECTORS VOTED AT THE 2023 ANNUAL MEETING THAT THERE WILL BE NO SPECIAL SET UPS FOR OSAA SPORTS OR ANY OTHER CONFLICTS. OHSRA ONLY COUNTS POINTS FOR YOUR BEST 8 RODEOS IN EACH EVENT, THUS GIVING EACH STUDENT LEWAY TO MISS A RODEO OR TWO IF NEEDED. ONCE A STUDENT HAS PLACED IN AN EVENT MORE THAN 8 TIMES THEY ARE ONLY WORKING TO BETTER THEIR BOTTOM SCORE. POINTS ARE GIVEN TO THE TOP 10 IN EACH EVENT AT EACH RODEO 10 FOR 1ST 1 FOR 10TH. THE TOP 20 CONTESTANTS IN EACH EVENT AT THE END OF THE PRELIMINARY RODEOS QUALIFY FOR THE STATE FINALS RODEO HELD IN JUNE.

LATE ENTRIES:

LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED, YOU WILL NEED TO EMAIL oregonhsrodeo@gmail.com TO BE ADDED AS A LATE ENTRY. LATE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED UNTIL THE FRIDAY AFTER THE DATE OF THE CLOSED ENTRY. \$20 LATE FEE WILL BE ACCESSED AND LATE FEE'S WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE DRAW. ROUGH STOCK, BARREL RACERS AND POLE BENDERS WILL BE PLACED AT THE END OF EACH DRAW AND ROPERS WILL GO FIRST.

TURNING OUT OF A RODEO:

IF YOU NEED TO MEDICAL OUT OR VET OUT OF THE RODEO AFTER YOU HAVE ENTERED YOU NEED TO EMAIL THE OHSRA OFFICE oregonhsrodeo@gmail.com OR CALL 541-546-7007 AND LEAVE A MESSAGE. YOU MUST NOTIFY AT LEAST TWO HOURS BEFORE THE RODEO PERFORMANCE. IF YOU NO SHOW YOU WILL BE PLACED ON THE SUSPENDED LIST AND WILL NOT BE ABLE TO COMPETE UNTIL YOUR ENTRY FEE'S AND FINES FOR NOT SHOWING ARE PAID. IF THIS IS THE CASE, YOU WILL BE SENT AN INVOICE THROUGH THE OHSRA QUICKBOOKS TO PAY ONLINE, THIS WILL NEED TO BE DONE BEFORE YOU CAN ENTER ANOTHER RODEO.

RESULTS AND POINTS:

RESULTS FOR EACH RODEO WILL BE POSTED NO LATER THAN THE MONDAY AFTER THE RODEO WEEKEND. PLEASE CHECK THESE RESULTS, WE RELY ON YOU TO CHECK THEM SO THAT POINTS ARE GIVEN CORRECTLY. POINTS WILL BE UPDATED BY WEDNESDAY AFTER THE RODEO WEEKEND. WE ASK THAT YOU KEEP AN EYE ON THE POINTS AS WELL, MISTAKES ARE MADE AND IT IS UP TO YOU TO BRING THOSE MISTAKES TO OUR ATTENTION. RODEO ATTIRE:

WESTERN ATTIRE IS REQUIRED AT EACH RODEO DURING THE RODEO AND 1 HOUR PRIOR TO IT. WESTERN ATTIRE IS OUTLINED IN THE NHSRA RULEBOOK, THIS GOES FOR ALL COMPETITORS AND ANY PARENTS THAT ARE HELPING THEIR CHILD, EVEN BEHIND THE BUCKING AND ROPING CHUTES. PARENTS NOT IN WESTERN ATTIRE WILL RESULT IN A DQ FOR THEIR STUDENT.

DISCREPANCIES:

IF FOR SOME REASON THERE IS A DISCREPANCY IN THE ARENA WITH A RUN OR RIDE, THE STUDENT MUST FIRST GO TO THE STUDENT DIRECTOR, THE STUDENT DIRECTOR AND THE STUDENT WITH THE DISCREPANCY MAY THEN GO TO THE JUDGE. PARENTS MUST 100% STAY OUT OF ANY DISCREPANCY, A PARENT GOING TO ANY DIRECTOR OR JUDGE WILL DISCREPANCY WILL RESULT IN A DISQUALIFICATION OF THEIR CHILD.

HAT FINES:

HAT FINES ARE ASSESSED TO ANY BARREL RACER OR POLE BENDER LOSING THEIR HAT. A HAT FINE IS \$25 AND CAN BE PAID AT THE RODEO OFFICE OR WILL BE INVOICED TO THE STUDENT THROUGH THE OHSRA QUICKBOOKS INVOICING. THESE FINES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU CAN COMPETE AT THE NEXT RODEO.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELVES:

THERE HAS BEEN MANY PHONE CALLS REGARDING HOW OHSRA MEMBERS ARE LEAVING THE GROUNDS AT THE END OF THE WEEKEND AFTER A RODEO. MANY OF THESE FACILITIES ARE GIVING LARGE DISCOUNTS TO THE CLUB PRODUCING THE RODEO. PLEASE PICK UP ALL OF YOUR TRASH. PLEASE PICK UP YOUR HORSE MANURE AND ANY LEFTOVER FEED AND EITHER PUT IT BACK INTO YOUR TRAILER OR PUT IT IN ONE OF THE DESIGNATED AREAS ON THE GROUNDS. IF YOUR HORSE DIGS A HOLE, FILL IT IN. WE WANT TO CONTINUE TO HAVE RODEOS AT THESE FACILITIES AND YOUR RESPECT FOR THE GROUNDS AND THE PEOPLE WHO WORK HARD TO PRODUCE THE RODEOS ARE EXPECTED.
